### **OUR STATEMENT OF FAITH**

The Presbyterian Church in America or "The PCA" is a distinctly evangelical denomination in the Reformed tradition. The Bible as the Word of God is the primary standard for our faith. The Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms, although subordinate to the Bible in their authority, set forth our understanding of biblical truth in a consistent, concise, and reliable form. In the Reformed tradition, there are five key tenets, among others, that we hold to: By Scripture Alone; By Christ Alone; By Grace Alone; By Faith Alone; and To God Alone be the Glory.

- We believe the Bible is the written word of God, inspired by the Holy Spirit
  and without error in the original manuscripts. The Bible is the revelation
  of God's truth and is infallible and authoritative in all matters of faith and
  practice.
- We believe in the Holy Trinity. There is one God, who exists eternally in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- We believe that all are sinners and totally unable to save themselves from God's displeasure, except by His mercy.
- We believe that salvation is by God alone as He sovereignly chooses those He will save. We believe His choice is based on His grace, not on any human individual merit, or foreseen faith.
- We believe that Jesus Christ is the eternal Son of God, who through His perfect life and sacrificial death atoned for the sins of all who will trust in Him, alone, for salvation.
- We believe that God is gracious and faithful to His people not simply as individuals but as families in successive generations according to His Covenant promises.
- We believe that the Holy Spirit indwells God's people and gives them the strength and wisdom to trust Christ and follow Him.
- We believe that Jesus will return, bodily and visibly, to judge all mankind and to receive His people to Himself.
- We believe that all aspects of our lives are to be lived to the glory of God under the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

## Questions and thoughts for discussion:

- 1. Proverbs 2 points us to the pursuit of the knowing God's wisdom. This is a moral quest for righteousness in our lives. How does this moral pursuit help us regarding our pursuit of answers for questions of direction and guidance in non-moral issues?
- 2. Why must we keep in mind that the Proverbs speak of life in general and are not specific guaranteed promises?
- 3. Consider: "Impressions are impressions. They are not in a special category. Don't confuse impressions, hunches, and subjective feelings with certain words from the Lord ... We all get intuitions and hunches and gut feelings all the time. Some are from the Lord. Some aren't. Most often, it probably doesn't matter." Kevin DeYoung
- 4. The Lord guides his people by his Spirit through Scripture. We are not to expect the unexpected nor make that the means of discerning God's guidance. Why do you think people insist on making the unexpected the norm?
- 5. The Lord is not playing a cosmic shell game with us where we have to guess under which choice his will is hidden. How does Deut. 29:29 help us understand this?
- 6. How might you help someone who is so wrapped up in knowing the future that they struggle to live in the present?
- 7. Often because of an inability to make wise and prudent decisions, people will try to 'spiritualize' the search for God's will. Where might you direct them in Scripture to avoid this error?
