Sermon Questions for Further Reflection

- 1. Reflect on the series of undercover videos released by the Center for Medical Progress, which show that Planned Parenthood profited from the sale of body parts from aborted babies. How did you feel when the videos were released? What did you think of the public response?
- 2. The public debate about the Planned Parenthood videos focused largely on the legality of selling fetal tissue. Pro-life advocates emphasized that profiting from the sale of fetal tissue was illegal, so the issue centered on if Planned Parenthood was making a profit or merely being reimbursed. What is the difference between a legal issue and a *moral* issue? How would it have affected the public discussion if pro-life supporters had emphasized that unborn children are treasured by God?
- 3. What has the Church done well in response to abortion?
- 4. How could the Church do better?
- 5. How can we best express God's love to women who have had abortions through our actions? Through our words?
