Sermon Questions

- 1. In the Bible, the heart is the rational, volitional, and emotional center of a person. Proverbs encourages us to use our abilities to pursue wisdom with a humility that recognizes the Lord is the one who establishes out plans. How does this encourage our trust in Him?
- 2. Consider: "While no one can fathom the divine wisdom or control God's will by the exercise of his own wisdom and virtue, one can conform to God's standards. Although this conformity does not guarantee the success of any particular undertaking, it does help secure ultimate well-being." —Michael Fox
- 3. Proverbs encourages us to plan for a future that we cannot secure. We live in the limits of our finiteness. As believers, why does our understanding of who God is keep us "in the game"?
- 4. In verse 4, we see that the Lord is in control of the actions of the wicked and uses their evil for his good purposes. How is this a comfort to us? What does it require of us?
- 5. Anxiety comes from the power we give to the unknown. Where do you struggle with this in your life right now? How does the gospel address you fears?

Children's Question

What comfort do we have knowing the Lord is in control of all things?

The Lord's Supper

The gospel is not only heard, but visibly seen as God invites us to commune with him at his table. In the Lord's Supper we remember and experience Jesus' saving work.

CELEBRATION OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

Wine is located in the two outer rings; juice is located in the center ring. (See FCC observance below)

PRAYER FOR THE CONGREGATION

At Faith Covenant, the Lord's Supper is observed each Lord's Day as the climax of our worship service. We invite to the Lord's Table all those who are baptized disciples of Jesus Christ, under the authority of Christ and His body, the Church. By eating the bread and drinking the cup with us as a visitor, you are acknowledging to our church that you are in covenant with God. You also acknowledge that you are a sinner, without hope except in the sovereign mercy of God, and that you are trusting in Jesus Christ alone for your salvation. If you have any doubts about your participation, please speak to the pastor or one of the elders after the service. Wine and bread are the elements of the supper as instituted by Jesus Christ. We recommend the use of wine; however we offer both juice and wine in the tray to allow true liberty of conscience.
