## **SCRIPTURE OF EXHORTATION:** Revelation 21:8





- <sup>3</sup> beside the gates in front of the town, at the entrance of the portals she cries aloud:
- <sup>4</sup> "To you, O men, I call, and my cry is to the children of man.

<sup>5</sup> O simple ones, learn prudence; O fools, learn sense.

- <sup>6</sup> Hear, for I will speak noble things, and from my lips will come what is right,
- <sup>7</sup> for my mouth will utter truth; wickedness is an abomination to my lips.
- <sup>8</sup> All the words of my mouth are righteous; there is nothing twisted or crooked in them.
- <sup>9</sup> They are all straight to him who understands, and right to those who find knowledge.
- <sup>10</sup> Take my instruction instead of silver, and knowledge rather than choice gold,
- <sup>11</sup> for wisdom is better than jewels, and all that you may desire cannot compare with her.

# Sermon Questions

- 1. Consider: "It is not enough to be receptive to wisdom; one must actively pursue it."—M.V. Fox. How are we to pursue wisdom?
- 2. There is an irony in that we are called to seek wisdom, yet wisdom is calling out to all of us. How does that correspond to the gospel?

### Sermon

God addresses and speaks to us by the reading and preaching of his Word. Both Christians and non-Christians need to hear the good news of salvation and grow in it.

- 3. Consider: "Real wisdom tends toward prosperity, but prosperity itself is never the wise person's ultimate goal."—T. Keller. Have you seen the reverse of this in your life where your motive was in the wrong spot in your pursuit of wisdom?
- 4. The personification of wisdom in 22-31 has been understood as speaking of Jesus by the early church (Colossians 1:15-17). How is Jesus the foundation of everything for the believer?
- 5. Wisdom can include knowledge and "smarts" but it is at its heart a right relationship with the Lord. How does this drive our understanding in Proverbs?
