Call to Confession

COMMON CONFESSION OF SIN SCRIPTURE OF EXHORTATION: Psalm 37:3-5, 8-9

Trust in the LORD, and do good; dwell in the land and befriend faithfulness. Delight yourself in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him, and he will act. Refrain from anger, and forsake wrath! Fret not yourself; it tends only to evil. For the evildoers shall be cut off, but those who wait for the LORD shall inherit the land.

All: Give ear to my words, O LORD; the sound of my cry, for you are not a God who delights in wickedness; evil may not dwell with you. Yet, my heart is often filled with wicked and lustful thoughts, and I delight in my desires and not yours. The boastful shall not stand before your eyes; you hate all evildoers. Sermon Questions

- 1. Consider: "Christian freedom is freedom to love and therefore to serve."—Timothy George. Our freedom in Christ is to love and serve. How is this contrary to what many think of freedom?
- 2. Consider: "A Christian is free and independent in every respect, a bond servant to none. A Christian is a dutiful servant in every respect, owing a duty to everyone." —Martin Luther. How does our freedom in Christ make us bound to one another?
- 3. How does the grace of God in your life position you to move toward others in love and service?
- 4. What has been a personal challenge to you in putting the needs of others before your own? How does this look when dealing with people who either are non-Christians or have opinions opposite your own?

Children's Question

How has serving others been hard for you at times? How does your faith in Christ help you to serve even when your heart doesn't want to?
