#### God Calls Us

Wisdom: Keep It and It Will Keep You — Proverbs 3:21-35 (ESV)

<sup>21</sup> My son, do not lose sight of these—keep sound wisdom and discretion, <sup>22</sup> and they will be life for your soul and adornment for your neck. <sup>23</sup> Then you will walk on your way securely, and your foot will not stumble. ...

<sup>27</sup> Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in your power to do it. <sup>28</sup> Do not say to your neighbor, "Go, and come again, to-morrow I will give it"—when you have it with you. <sup>29</sup> Do not plan evil against your neighbor, who dwells trustingly beside you. ...

The Lord's curse is on the house of the wicked, but he blesses the dwelling of the righteous. <sup>34</sup> Toward the scorners he is scornful, but to the humble he gives favor. <sup>35</sup> The wise will inherit honor, but fools get disgrace.

# **Sermon Questions?**

- 1. Verses 21-23 include multiple body parts "eyes, throat, neck, feet." Why might Solomon have written about wisdom this way?
- 2. Derek Kidner has remarked, "It becomes very clear that wisdom means walking with God." Why might he state that? Can someone have wisdom without walking with God?
- 3. Verses 25-31 contain a series of six "Do nots." What is the theme of these prohibitions? Do you react differently to a negative prohibition "Do not" versus a positive proscription "Do"? Why do you suppose that is, and is that a good thing?
- 4. What is the essential message of these proverbs and how can that change us?
