Sermon Series: Numbers: A Pilgrim People Pastor John Sackett Follow Me: Numbers 9:15-10:10

Numbers 9:15-18

¹⁵On the day that the tabernacle was set up, the cloud covered the tabernacle, the tent of the testimony. And at evening it was over the tabernacle like the appearance of fire until morning. ¹⁶So it was always: the cloud covered it by day and the appearance of fire by night. ¹⁷And whenever the cloud lifted from over the tent, after that the people of Israel set out, and in the place where the cloud settled down, there the people of Israel camped. ¹⁸At the command of the Lord the people of Israel set out, and at the command of the Lord they camped. As long as the cloud rested over the tabernacle, they remained in camp.

Numbers 10:8-10

⁸And the sons of Aaron, the priests, shall blow the trumpets. The trumpets shall be to you for a perpetual statute throughout your generations. ⁹And when you go to war in your land against the adversary who oppresses you, then you shall sound an alarm with the trumpets, that you may be remembered before the Lord your God, and you shall be saved from your enemies. ¹⁰On the day of your gladness also, and at your appointed feasts and at the beginnings of your months, you shall blow the trumpets over your burnt offerings and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings. They shall be a reminder of you before your God: I am the Lord your God."

Sermon

God addresses and speaks to us by the reading and preaching of his Word. Both Christians and non-Christians need to hear the good news of salvation and grow in it.

Questions for Further Reflection:

- 1. God regularly associates, or represents, Himself with a cloud. Why is this an effective picture of God?
- 2. Gordon Wenham notes, "The cloud hovering over the tabernacle was the perfect means of divine guidance: the people had to respond with perfect obedience." What keeps us from obedience? How can we work against that which distracts us from obedience?
- 3. The cloud also functioned to show God's presence. How can we experience God's presence in our lives today? Is it important to be able to experience God's presence?
- 4. OT Scholar Timothy Ashley summarizes the trumpets' roll as to summon God's people to action. Who calls you—or *how* are you called—into action?
- 5. In John 10, Jesus reminds us that His sheep know His voice and follow Him. What voices are we training ourselves to listen to? How can we labor to "know" Jesus' voice?

Children's Question

Do you ever close your eyes as you listen to people talking and try to figure out whose voice is whose? Can you recognize your mom's and dad's voices?

Jesus says, "My sheep know my voice."

How can you learn to recognize His voice?
