SERMON TEXT: Mark 10:13-16 (ESV)

MARK 10:13-16

¹³ And they were bringing children to him that he might touch them, and the disciples rebuked them. ¹⁴ But when Jesus saw it, he was indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God. ¹⁵ Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it." ¹⁶ And he took them in his arms and blessed them, laying his hands on them.

DEUTERONOMY 6:4-7

⁴ "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. ⁵ You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶ And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

DEUTERONOMY 4:9

⁹ Only take care, and keep your soul diligently, lest you forget the things that your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. Make them known to your children and your children's children.

Why Should Children Attend the Worship Service? (taken from Jason Helopoulos)

- 1. Our children are members of the covenant community (the church): (Acts 2:42; Eph 10:24-25).
- 2. Our children will be present in the midst of the means of grace: (Rom 10:14),(Matt 28:19-20),(Acts 2:42-47).
- 3. Our children will be present in the midst of the entire congregation: (Deut 31:9-13).
- 4. Our children will be present with their parents.
- 5. Our children will witness their parents worshipping: (Deut. 6; Psalm 78; Eph. 6) (Ex 12:1-28; Deut. 4:9-11; Deut. 6; Psalm 78; Ezra 10:1; Nehemiah 12:43; Joel 2:12-17; Acts 16:33).
- 6. Our children will learn the rhythms of church life.

Questions and thoughts for discussion:

- 1. Consider: "Many churches today have become obsessed with youth culture, idolizing whatever is new, fresh, and cutting edge, particularly in the area of worship." -Eryn Sun
- 2. "I see congregations where there is such an attachment to all the entrapments of youth in America and this fundamental belief that we're not going to get old or that we can be both old and young at the same time."—Isaac Wardell
- 3. How do we receive the kingdom like a child?
- 4. Why is it that in a culture that idolizes youth, that many children are not allowed in the worship services?
- 5. What are ways we can break out of single generation worship?
- 6. What causes us to grow and be stretched in our walk with the Lord? How do we exercise certain areas of our heart?
- 7. Standing against our culture will always come at a cost. It is easy to do nothing, yet this has enormous consequences down the road (just think of the crisis with our national debt). In what areas has this series on worship challenged your thinking? What does action in that area look like for you?
