SERMON TEXT: Ephesians 1:1-6 (ESV)

¹ Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus, and are faithful in Christ Jesus: ² Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. ³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, ⁴ even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love ⁵ he predestined us for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, ⁶ to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved.

Questions and thoughts for discussion:

- 1. What was the purpose for Paul sending this letter?
- 2. Ephesians stands in stark contrast to the religions of the world. "Do this in order that you might live" is replaced by Paul with "Live in Christ so that you can do."
- 3. Most of the first chapter is one long sentence in Greek. Why do you think Paul kept layering his thoughts like this?
- 4. Why does Paul mention "by the will of God" in v-1?
- 5. "Faithful" in v-1 is not used in contrast to those who are 'unfaithful,' rather it speaks of those who believe in Jesus. The Greek word is the same for 'belief' and 'faith.'
- 6. According to Ephesians, what are "spiritual blessings?"
- 7. Why are people bothered by the Bible's clear teaching on predestination? Is it that many are trying to defend God from a charge of injustice or that they inwardly chafe at his absolute sovereignty?
- 8. Nowhere does Paul qualify his statements about God's supremacy. Why is it that so many add in "...in a way that does not violate man's free will" or "of course Paul means God foresaw our choices."
- 9. What does it mean that you are blessed in Christ?
